Note: The final appropriation for LIHEAP for FY 2005 increased regular grant funds from \$1.789 billion plus \$99.4 million in emergency funds in FY 2004 to \$1.9 billion in regular funds plus \$300 million in emergency funds for FY 2005. The appropriation also includes a 0.08 percent across the board cut – bringing the total appropriation to \$1.885 billion plus \$297.6 million in emergency funds for a total increase of 15.5% or about \$300 million over last year.
