1/ The FY 08 Appropriations Act includes \$590.3 million in contingency funds for a total appropriation of \$2.57 billion.

With the 1/16 release of \$450 million and 2/22 release of \$40 million there is a total \$100.3 million in FY 08 funds and \$20 million in carryover contingency funds remaining for a total of \$120.3 million.

2/ The FY 09 Adm. Budget includes \$1.7 billion in block grant and \$300 million in contingency funds for a total request of \$2 billion.

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
