1/ The FY 10 appropriation provides \$5.1 billion of which \$4.5 billion was allocated by a modified basic grant formula and \$590.3 million is provided in contingency funds.

2/ P.L. 112-10, the Full Year Continuing Resolution, provided funding for LIHEAP through September 30, 2011 at \$4.7 billion.

Of this amount, \$4.5 billion was provided for the basic grant and \$200 million in contingency funds which have been released.
